

What to Bring to Good Works Work Camp

Work Crew Items

Good Works will provide:

- Health & Safety Kits
- All Tools & Building Materials
- Water Bottles
- 1 Good Works Volunteer T-Shirt

Youth Group/Church should provide for *each* Work Crew:

- Cooler for lunches
- Additional water (such as large jugs you can refill each day or extra plastic gallons)
- Work Gloves for *each* volunteer
- Fans (for worksite & sleeping at night)
- Recreation equipment (soccer balls, soft balls, etc.)

Personal Items

Work Clothes:

Dress in layers and be prepared for rain; temperature and weather changes can be unpredictable year-round!

Jeans or **long pants** and **t-shirts** are appropriate attire at the work site. You may also need a **sweatshirt** or jacket and **rain gear**. Shorts are appropriate for some work, but you may want long pants for many of the planned jobs. Bring a pair of **hard-soled shoes** or a heavy duty pair of sneakers and individual **work gloves**.

Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times at the work site

Leisure Clothes:

Pack comfortable, appropriate clothing to wear at the church and other places away from the work site.

At no time will halter/tank tops, half shirts, short shorts or mini-skirts be acceptable

Personal Toiletries:

Soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, towels, wash cloths, **shower shoes** (flip flops/slides), **small tote bag** for carrying items to Warehouse showers.

Showers will only be available at the end of each work day, before returning to the host church

Additional Personal Items:

Sleeping bag/pillow, optional cot or air mattress (sleeping arrangements are on the floor of the church's classrooms), rain jacket, **Bible**, **pen/paper**, hat, **sunscreen**, sunglasses, board games or cards, **flashlight**.

You will not need any money except for occasional visit to ice cream or convenience store
