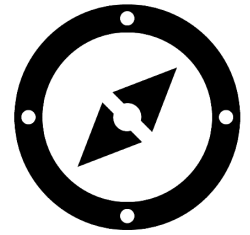


Offense

The Bait of Satan



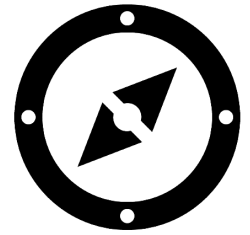

Luke 17:1 “**It is impossible that no offenses should come**, but woe to him through whom they do come! ”

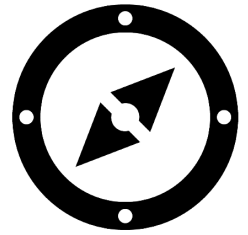
Proverbs 18:19 “**A brother offended** is harder to win than a strong city. ”

Proverbs 19:11 “The discretion of a man makes him **slow to anger**, And his glory is to overlook a transgression.”

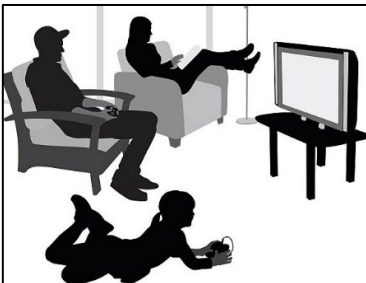
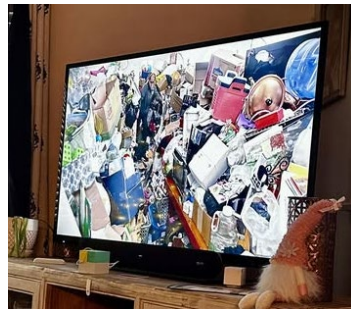

Empathize

Repent

“Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord “ Acts 3:19

Before addressing someone else's wrong, you must look at your own heart. Acknowledge any sinful reactions you had to the offense—such as harboring resentment, gossiping, or plotting revenge. Repentance means taking responsibility for your own thoughts and actions.

Forgive

“If you forgive others their sins, your heavenly Father will forgive you; but if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive you.” Luke 17:3–4

Christians are called to extend grace and forgive others just as God forgave them. This means releasing your right to retaliate and choosing not to hold the offense against the person in your mind, allowing you to experience personal freedom.

Escrow Forgiveness

- Forgiveness can be excruciating... and confusing
- Forgiveness does/does not hinge on Repentance?
- Forgiveness is not automatic for the unrepentant
- Forgiveness means to pardon an offender by paying his moral debt.
- We pay the debt. It's now out of our hands.
- When writing the moral check, remember it's not our money.
